KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. To drive Condover College Ltd vehicles.
- 2. To transport service users to and from their appropriate Home, Health, Education or Social Services establishments and ensure their safety on journeys.

- 4. To inspect vehicles on a daily basis and ensure that they are clean, well maintained and filled with fuel.
- 5. Maintains accurate, up-to-date records on trip sheets, vehicle maintenance, fuel purchases, incident reports, accident reports, vehicle condition reports and other records that are requested from management.
- 6. To assist the young people to transfer into their wheelchair and move from home etc and to assist with moving into adapted vehicle
- 7. To ensure that wheelchairs are clamped into the vehicle in accordance with established guidelines
- 8. Perform minor maintenance tasks on assigned vehicle(s) as required
- 9. Coordinate the schedule for major or periodic vehicle maintenance with management and staff to minimize service interruptions

- 10. Responds immediately to accident or medical emergencies by notifying emergency response providers, and rendering First Aid until emergency personnel arrive
- 11. Serves as a positive role model while providing transportation service
- 12. To follow Condover College's Mission statement
- 13. Any other duties of a related nature which might reasonably be required and allocated by the Transport Manager
